WORLD RECORD ATTEMPT

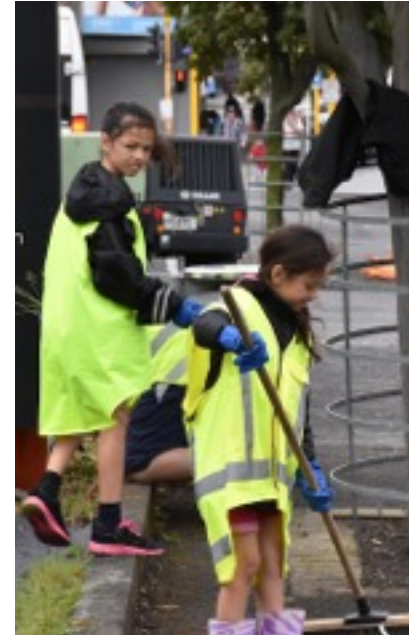
On 30 April 2016 the Manukau Beautification Charitable Trust will attempt to set a world record for the largest number of volunteers at a community clean up.
